RSCL WIFI policy

The RSCL allows for personal devices to access the Internet via a unsecured, unencrypted wireless network throughout the entire building.

Use of the Library wireless and electrical connections is entirely at the risk of the user. Users should be familiar with their own personal wireless device and how to connect their own devices to a wireless network.

Library staff will not provide technical assistance with personal devices or configurations and will not change settings and cannot guarantee that the user will be able to make a wireless connection. If the user has problems accessing the Internet over this connection, the staff will verify the Library's wireless connection is working.

The Library does not offer power strips, wireless network cards, mouse pads, storage devices, cables, etc. to the public nor can the Library guarantee access to power outlets. Printers are not available via the wireless connection.

The Library assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment. Users must keep their equipment with them at all times.

The Library's wireless connection is in unencrypted and unfiltered. Use of this connection is done at patrons own risk. By using this connection, users acknowledge that compromised personal information, security errors, viruses, hacking, electrical surges, or damage to hardware and software are a risk associated with wireless service. By using the wireless service patrons agree they are assuming such risk, and hold the library harmless from any claim or loss arising from such instance.

All users are expected to use the library's wireless access in a legal and responsible manner, consistent with the educational and informational purposes for which it is provided.

Any restriction or monitoring of a minor's access to the Library's wireless network is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian. The RSCL assumes no responsibility for the use of the Internet by children. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to determine what is appropriate for children.
